One thing I learned very quickly while growing up near my dad’s tool shed was to make sure I had the right tool for the job. Now, certainly that seems obvious, up until the point that we can’t find the screwdriver, so the hammer is convenient to drive that last screw, or perhaps I need to use the flathead as a prybar on some staple it has no business pulling up. We do know better but in a pinch we may use the right tool for the wrong thing. But we really should use the right tools for the right jobs!

The Gospel this weekend is rather confusing because it seems that Jesus, as He tells us this parable of a steward squandering his master’s property, extols the virtue of this dishonest steward. Yet, it is not Jesus praying the vice of lying, cheating, or stealing. Rather what He is praising is that even this poor, dishonest steward understands the basic hierarchy of the world around him- and that he needs friends more than he needs to hold on to his master’s goods or his position.

It is a lesson that we are often taught and seldom remember. We need to use or engage with things or people in the right way. God first, our neighbors, and then everything else flows in beneath that. But too often we are using people, loving things, and putting God in a holding pattern until we get to Him. If we understand that He is the source of what we need- and that we need to put people above things- and that this will make us happy- maybe we will start using the right tools for the right jobs, just like the dishonest steward eventually did.
