It is a venerable and time-honored practice in the Catholic Church to pray for the dead, and to even offer sacrifice for them as well. We recognize that, at the end of this life, it is very difficult for each person to be "perfect" in every way, meaning that we are totally detached from sin, grudges, and our weaknesses, and ready to meet the Lord. Purgatory, even as it is a place of purgation and of repentance, is a place of hope, as the faithful present in purgatory are given assurance that Heaven can be theirs even after their time of purification.

They are not alone on their path- and we as the members of the Church militant on earth are charged with the duty to pray for them and to offer sacrifices for them, especially during the month of November. During this time, in which we remember the faithful departed, a special opportunity exists during the first eight days of November to gain a plenary indulgence each day for a soul to be released into heaven from their purification. A plenary indulgence is the complete remission of the punishment due to sin for any individual- living or dead- and we can gain eight of them during these first eight days.

The conditions are simple: we must go to a cemetery each day we wish to receive the indulgence, say a prayer there for the dead, be sure to be free from grave (mortal) sin, receive the Eucharist and the sacrament of Reconciliation once during that time (or up to eight days prior to or after the eight days). Use this opportunity well to pray for the faithful departed who have gone before us- and rest in the hope of life eternal in Heaven!
