In a scene of the classic Disney cartoon "The Lion King," there is a moment where Simba and Mufasa are sitting together on a high vantage point. Mufasa explains to his son the extent of their kingdom- and it was everywhere the light touches. He was the ruler over all the animals, and over everything that the light touched- but he was not to go any further than that, into the "shadowy places."

Christ the King Sunday is the last Sunday of the Church liturgical calendar to crown out the year with a simple statement: Christ is King. While the statement is simple, the meaning in it is not. Christ is King- but not just in Heaven. Christ is King, but not just amongst the angels. Christ is our King- and wants to be our King if we let Him. He may not be seen as the physical ruler of our government, but He wants to be King of our hearts and souls, and all that is within. He wants to be King of your life. Of your successes. Of the things you are proud of. That we would expect. However, He also wants to be King in unexpected ways as well. King as you carry your cross. King as you suffer. King as you grieve. King even as you worry or struggle to find the meaning of life. He wants to be a King that is not seen to be a tyrant, but a loving Lord and Savior.

As we celebrate Christ the King Sunday, don't let Him be Lord of just where you think the light should touch. Let Him be King of everything- even the "shadowy" places you'd rather not let the light of Christ hit.
