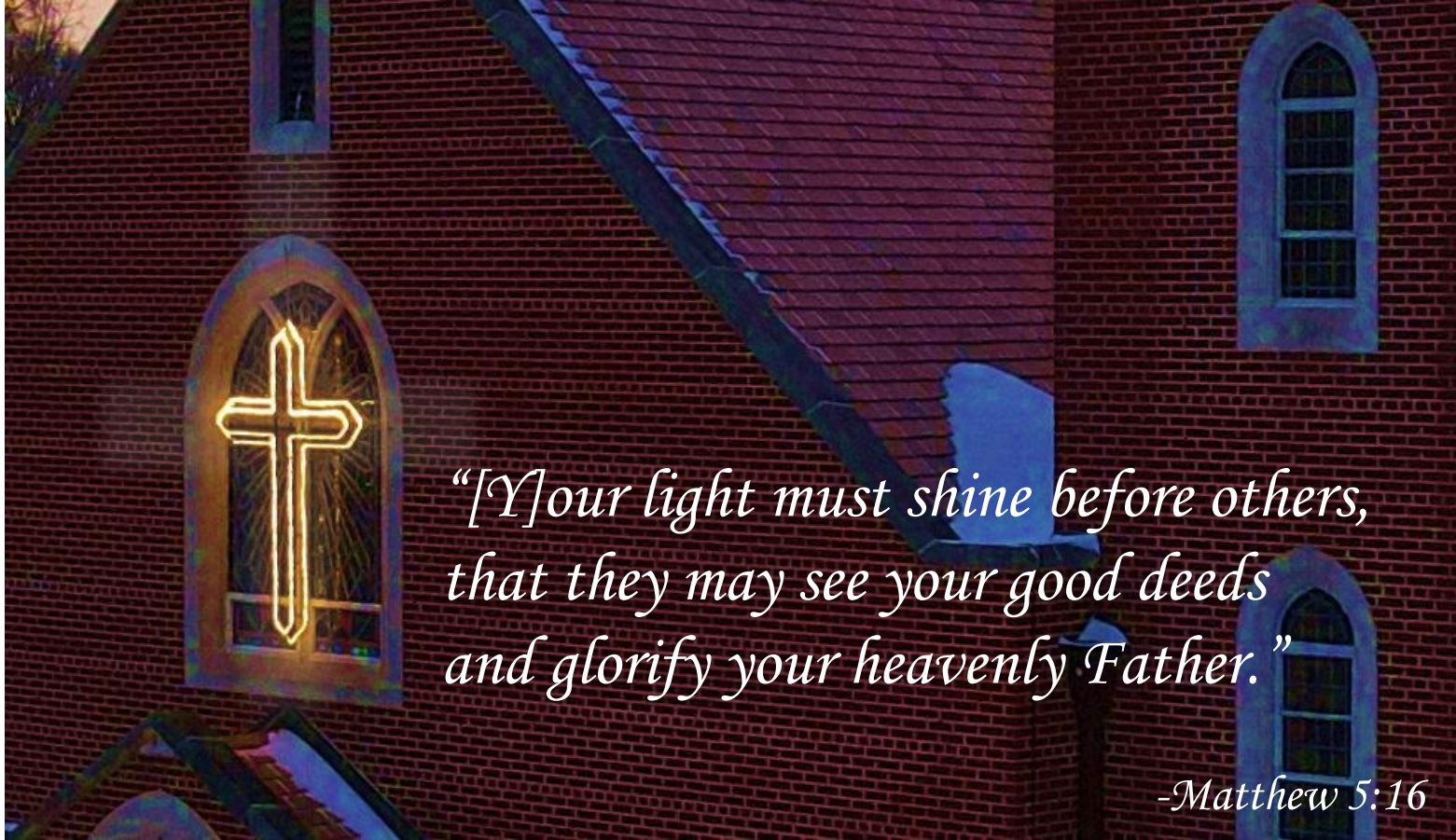

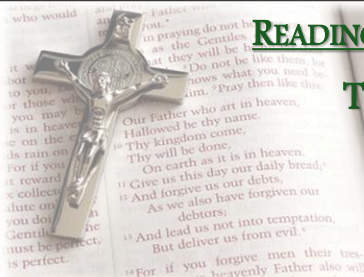

You really don't have to look far in this world to discover how much darkness there really is. The divide between political parties, the complete devaluing of life, at any moment, the removal of Gospel values from public life. We see sin being celebrated and even enshrined in various ways, and it seems like hatred and selfishness are the creeds that we see presented online and even in person to some extent. Amongst many, many social issues, amongst great hopelessness, and amongst great evil and tragedies in our time- and we stand in the midst of them.

I always go back to a line in the Lord of the Rings, in the midst of such times. Frodo, in speaking to Gandolf- his wizardly mentor- expresses great sorrow that he had been given such a great task and lived in such times. Gandolf gently reminded him that it was not up to him to choose the time nor the task- but simply to choose what was able to be done with the time and task given him.

I fear that at times it can be too easy for us to lose hope or even lose sight of what we are to do in the midst of our times. Maybe we feel our culture is too far gone. Maybe evil too rampant. Perhaps we should just wish for the second coming.

Or... we can do as the Gospel reminds us. We are meant to be light- even in the midst of such great darkness. Perhaps by being light- by being holy, and by being people formed in virtue and intentional in our relationship with God- we will find ourselves turning the tide against such dark times.
