

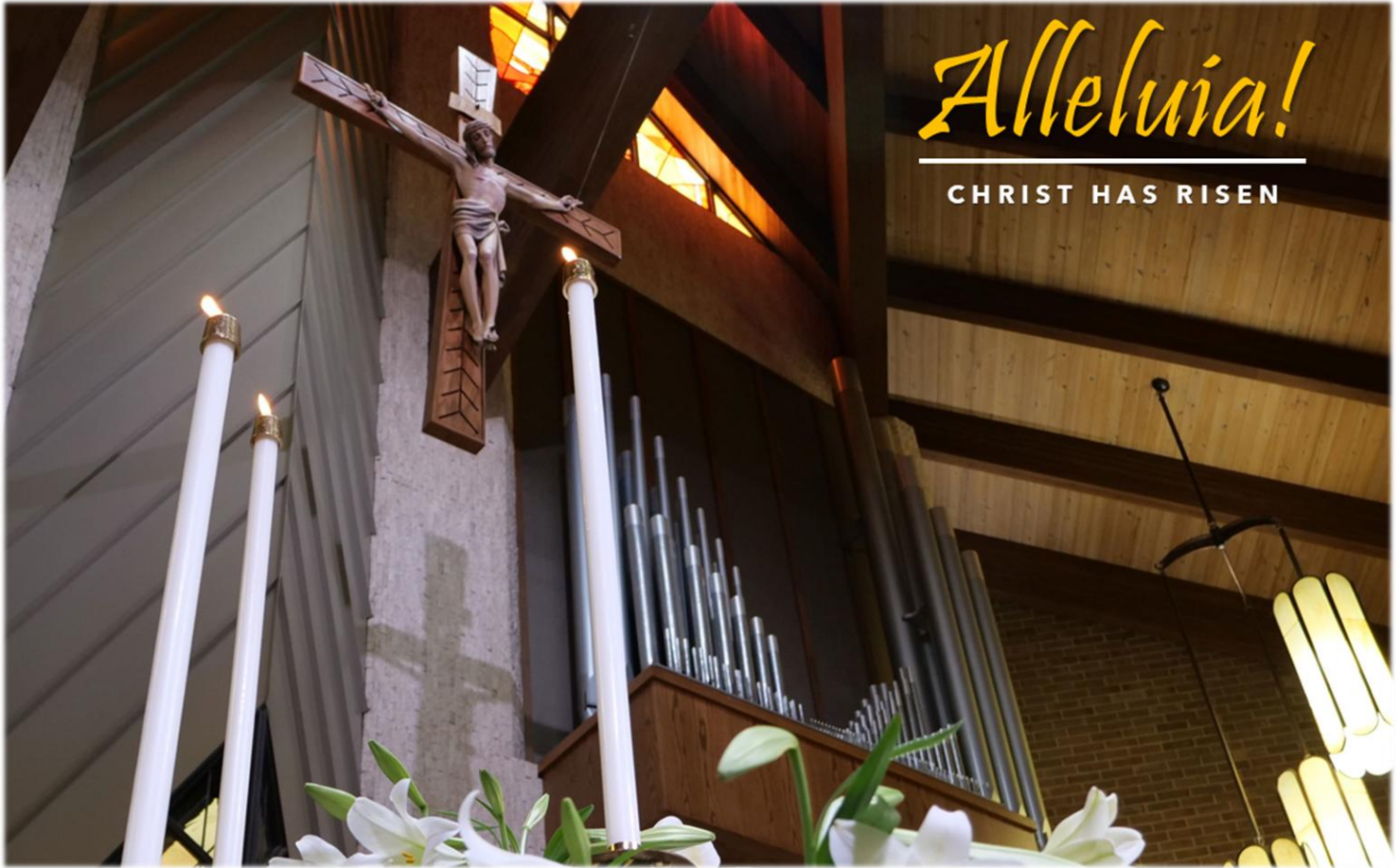

As we enter into this sacred season of Easter, it is supposed to be a season of joy and of triumph for all of us. We have an easier time with this in many respects, whether it is the beautiful way our churches have been decorated, or the familiar hymns, and perhaps even the slight warmth of the smell of incense. Yet, even as this happens for us, the perspective of the disciples is not something we should miss. The Gospel today tells us that they “saw, and they believed” even though they had not yet understood what was to take place. This gives us an idea of what they were feeling- that there was an air of mystery to this moment, as they tried to wrap their heads around what had happened, even as they grappled with great sorrow. That great triumph was met with their sorrows and their difficulties.

It can be tempting for some of us to write off the joy of the Easter season. Perhaps we feel we didn’t “do Lent” as best as we could’ve. Perhaps we are stuck in sorrow from a loss or from the hard life has dealt us. Maybe we just feel that the Resurrection is much ado about nothing, or at least that is the way our heart receives it.

The thing about this line from the disciples- they “saw and they believed”: it tells you and I something important. The Resurrection came to meet our particular life- and our struggles, and even the things we suffer and feel no one else sees. The power of Christ’s Resurrection comes to encounter us in these places- we may see all that is going on in the church during this season, may we receive the grace to also believe it has come to save us in particular.

On behalf of myself, and all my staff: Happy Easter. May you experience the joy of our risen Savior in a new way- and may He truly set you free!
